AGES: Reception – Year 9

Chess is a great learning tool that enables children to develop the basic thinking skills that are used when playing chess; problem solving, forward planning, lateral, logical and sequential thinking as well as memory, visualisation and verbalisation. These cognitive skills are developed using chess as a medium. Learning while playing!

We use a qualified instructor who uses a structured method of teaching to maximise the educational benefits of playing chess. Each lesson children are introduced to a new idea or theme with the dual aims of improving your child’s chess playing ability and enriching their mental facilities. Each term students play a round robin tournament with students from their group.

Students are divided into two groups (Tuesday or Wednesday) to better meet the needs of all students.
