Please note that interviews are not compulsory and need only be made if you would like to discuss any issues with your child's teacher.

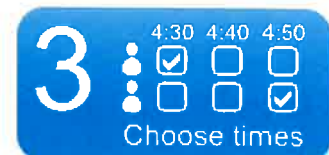

Enter either the **primary** or **secondary** school event code.

Then follow the 3 simple steps.



Primary & Secondary - Bookings close at 11am the morning of the first interview day so teachers can print off their lists for that afternoon.

Bookings will then be reopened 8am the next morning until 11am for last minute bookings for the second night.



When you click **finish**, your interview timetable will be emailed to you automatically - **check your junk mail folder** if you do not receive your email immediately.

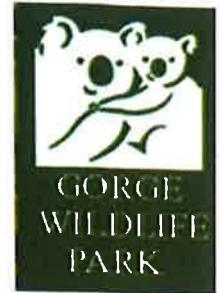
WEEK TWO

GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOKINGS

A lot of time and planning goes into our Vacation Care Program. We would appreciate all users booking into the program as soon as possible, if there are no more vacancies at time of booking, you will be advised that you have been placed on a waiting list for that day as will be contacted if a vacancy arises. If you need to cancel a booking, this must be done the day before the booking, this enables us to offer the place to someone on the waiting list, if a booking is not cancelled, you will be charged an Allowable Absence for that day. If a child wakes up sick on the morning of the booked day, the place will not be charged as long as OSHC is notified before 8am that day.

BEHAVIOUR

All children are expected to respect each other, staff, visitors, parents and anyone else in attendance at the centre as well as respect each others property. Children with unacceptable behaviour will be placed in time out. Continued unacceptable behaviour will result in a parent being contacted and possible expulsion from the program.

LOST PROPERTY & CHILDRENS PERSONAL ITEMS BROUGHT TO OSHC

The children are expected to keep their belongings in their own bag. Any items of clothes that are removed (jackets, shoes, hats etc) must be put into child's bag immediately. Whilst all care is taken to return children's belongings to them, no responsibility will be taken by OSHC for lost or damaged property. It is recommended that all property is labelled. OSHC discourages children bringing IT items to Vacation Care and also advises that if brought, these items are not able to be charged at the centre.

EXCURSIONS

Children need to arrive at OSHC by the specified departure time. If a child does not arrive by departure time and we have not heard from the parent, we will go without them. Spending money is only permitted if specified in the program or arrangements are made with staff.

FOOD AND CLOTHING

Children are required to wear clothing appropriate to the weather on the day. Hats are to be brought every day and worn when the UV requires (OSHC staff will know), Children are required to wear shoes outside, Breakfast and afternoon tea is NOT provided during Vacation Care. Please provide your child/ren with plenty to eat & drink.

MEDICATION

Children who require medication to be administered need to have the 'Permission to administer medication' book signed, All medication must be clearly labelled with the childs name, dosage and administration time. Children who require medication which assists improved behaviour MUST have their medication supplied/administered on the day. If medication is not supplied/administered, the child will not be accepted into the program.
