Dear Parents

Next term we have been asked to host a group of Korean and Japanese students coming to Australia between 22 July and 1 September. As a result, we are looking for homestay families for these children. 10 Japanese Student will be coming for 18 days, 2 Korean Students staying for 4 weeks and 5 Korean Students staying for 6 weeks.

Homestay is supervised by the school and we have certain guidelines that need to be followed. In order for you to be able to have children stay in your home we require you to complete a Homestay Form and complete the necessary police checks. The school funds these, but it is the responsibility of the individual to take the necessary paperwork to the police station and get the forms signed. I also am required to sight your driver's license. We also require a photo of your family as these are forwarded to the parents in Korea and Japan along with your completed homestay form. The payment to homestay families is \$250 per child for each week.

If you are interested in being a homestay family and have not completed the required forms, please make sure you check the box that you require the forms to be sent home. If you have already registered as a homestay family, you only need return the Registration of Interest.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOKINGS

A lot of time and planning goes into our Vacation Care Program. We would appreciate all users booking into the program as soon as possible, if there are no more vacancies at time of booking, you will be advised that you have been placed on a waiting list for that day and will be contacted if a vacancy arises. If you need to cancel a booking, this must be done the day before the booking, this enables us to offer the place to someone on the waiting list, if a booking is not cancelled, you will be charged an Allowable Absence for that day. If a child wakes up sick on the morning of the booked day, the place will not be charged as long as OSHC is notified before 8am that day.

BEHAVIOUR

All children are expected to respect each other, staff, visitors, parents and anyone else in attendance at the centre as well as respect each others property. Children with unacceptable behaviour will be placed in time out. Continued unacceptable behaviour will result in a parent being contacted and possible expulsion from the program.

LOST PROPERTY & CHILDRENS PERSONAL ITEMS BROUGHT TO OSHC

The children are expected to keep their belongings in their own bag. Any items of clothes that are removed (jackets, shoes, hats etc) must be put into child's bag immediately. Whilst all care is taken to return children's belongings to them, no responsibility will be taken by OSHC for lost or damaged property. It is recommended that all property is labelled. OSHC discourages children bringing IT items to Vacation Care and also advises that if brought, these items are not able to be charged at the centre.

EXCURSIONS

Children need to arrive at OSHC by the specified departure time. If a child does not arrive by departure time and we have not heard from the parent, we will go without them. Spending money is only permitted if specified in the program or arrangements are made with staff.

FOOD AND CLOTHING

Children are required to wear clothing appropriate to the weather on the day. Hats are to be brought every day and worn when the UV requires (OSHC staff will know), Children are required to wear shoes outside, Breakfast and afternoon tea is NOT provided during Vacation Care. Please provide your child/ren with plenty to eat & drink.

MEDICATION

Children who require medication to be administered need to have the 'Permission to administer medication' book signed, All medication must be clearly labelled with the childs name, dosage and administration time. Children who require medication which assists improved behaviour MUST have their medication supplied/administered on the day. If medication is not supplied/administered, the child will not be accepted into the program.
