**Please note that interviews are not compulsory and need only be made if you would like to discuss any issues with your child's teacher.**

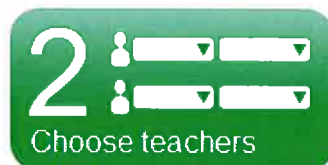

Enter either the **primary** or **secondary** school event code.

Then follow the 3 simple steps.



**Primary & Secondary** - Bookings close at 11am the morning of the first interview day so teachers can print off their lists for that afternoon.

Bookings will then be reopened 8am the next morning until 11am for last minute bookings for the second night.



When you click **finish**, your interview timetable will be emailed to you automatically - **check your junk mail folder** if you do not receive your email immediately.

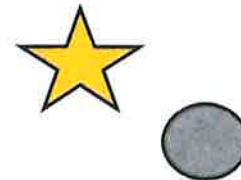

## SAPSASA ONKAPARINGA NORTH DISTRICT ATHLETICS CARNIVAL 2018



Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Your child has shown an interest to participate in the 2018 District Athletics Carnival. This will be the first year that Prescott College Southern has been involved!

Please read the information provided below and then complete the attached nomination form if you wish your child to be involved.

**When:** Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September (Term 3 Week 7)

**Where:** Christies Beach High School

**Time:**

8:45am	Marshalls Meeting at admin tent
9:00am	Opening Speeches
9:15am	Events begin
2:00pm	Presentations
2:15pm	Pack up

All children are expected to be at the venue from the opening speeches (9:00am) until after their last event. Program times are flexible and competitors must take particular note of announcement times for events. Children must remain out of the competition areas until called.

**Cost:**

There will be a cost of \$8.00 (GST exclusive) per student to participate, which will help to cover costs. Please keep the money at your school and you will receive an invoice at the conclusion of the day. On arrival please hand in the Participation Details form to the scorer's tent (attached with this package).

**Age groups:**

Students born in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008 are eligible to compete.

Students must compete only in their age group. ***Children are only permitted to enter three events and a relay.***

**Events:**

Track: 100m, 200m, 800m, 4x100m relay    Field: High jump, long jump, shot put, discus

Schools can nominate 2 competitors only for 800m and 100m. All other events schools must enter only 1 competitor.

**Officials:**

Each school will be responsible for the organisation / management of an event. Prescott is responsible for Girls Discus. We suggest 2 officials per school are nominated to cover the event for the day. Officials must already understand the event/scoring that is required. The ADULT officials at each event are responsible for scoring, presentation of ribbons and state day packs for winners. Each event will also have some student helpers from WC college and WC Primary. These students can measure, retrieve equipment, record results, or any other jobs you would like them to help with to ensure your event runs smoothly.

***If you have experience with Athletics, and are willing to help out can you please let Mrs Goding know.***

This carnival is for those students who are competent at athletics events. For this reason we recommend that to participate in this event you must be a part of an athletics club or have received a blue ribbon at our school Athletics Sports Day in Term 2.

Please keep in mind that each school is only allowed to enter a maximum of 2 students (same age and gender) into each event. If more than 2 students apply for the same event then we will run school trials.

**State Day:**

The Metro Athletic Championships will be held on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> September at Santos Stadium (Week 10 of Term 3).

***The nomination form must be returned to the front office no later than Friday 10/08/2018.***

Before accepting however, it is important to note that it is your responsibility to take your child to Christies Beach High by 8.50am. Parents are encouraged to stay however supervision will be provided by Prescott Staff. Students can leave after their events or return to school at the end of the day on the school bus. This is a SAPSASA run event, not a Prescott College event, although a staff representative will be there on the day.

Once the team has been finalised parents will be notified.
