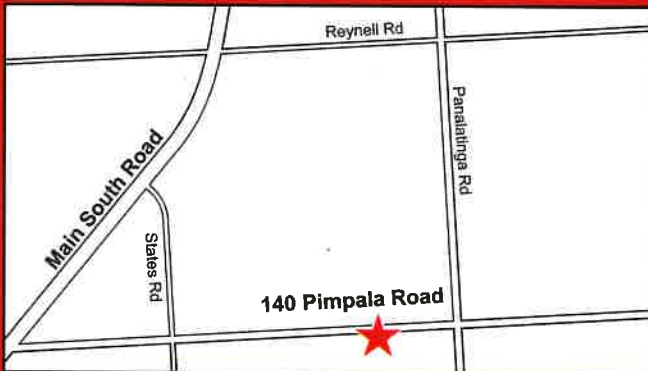
Bring your family, friends and colleagues to experience an outdoor theatrical presentation that brings to life the Biblical story and true meaning of Christmas.
