



Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome to Mini Ball 2019! Your child has expressed an interest in playing Mini Ball for Prescott College Southern in a Year 4/5 school team.

Games will be held on **Wednesday** afternoons at either 3:50pm, 4:35pm or 5:20pm. Games will consist of two 20-minute halves. Games are played at the **Morphett Vale Basketball Stadium**, located at 2 Sports Park Drive (off States Road), **Wilfred Taylor Reserve**.

Game times and information will be communicated via SMS and email each week. Future game times can be found on the Morphett Vale Basketball website, under fixtures, (the day the team plays), (the age group). <http://www.morphettvale.basketball.net.au/>

Students will need to be there 10 minutes before the game and have someone to supervise them (games run for approximately 40 minutes). Please note that due to staff commitments, a staff member will not be present at these games. Students are to wear their full school **PE uniform** to all games.

Each game costs \$5.50 per player. Students pay the \$5.50 as they come into the stadium. After paying, they will receive a ticket, and this ticket needs to go to their coach at the start of each game. If students do not have \$5.50 for their ticket, they will be unable to play.

A **registration fee of \$20 per player** will be charged to school accounts, to cover the singlet hire for the year. At the end of the year, this money will be used to purchase trophies for each player to recognise their participation and achievement. Presentations will occur during an Assembly or Combined Worship near the end of the year. Players who discontinue playing prior to the commencement of Term 3 will have their registration fee refunded when the singlet is returned to the school and a trophy will not be ordered.

Your child will be allocated a team if their consent form is returned in Week 2 of Term 1. Each child will be given a singlet to use for the duration of Mini Ball. Once your child finishes playing, the singlet is to be returned to the school.

In order for teams to participate, **the school requires 1-2 parents/caregivers to be available for team coordinating and assist coaching.** If you could assist, your help would be greatly appreciated.

I will be coordinating the teams and look forward to working with you. If you have any further questions about the after school Mini Ball program, please don't hesitate to contact me.

- Respect the umpire's decision. Learn from them and adjust to their decision. Understand that many umpires may be junior or trainee umpires and should be encouraged rather than abused.
- Treat others the way you would like to be treated and think before you act.
- The stadium has a zero-tolerance policy towards any abusive and/or inappropriate behaviour. Individuals will be asked to immediately leave the stadium if such behaviour occurs towards anyone including players, coaches, referees, officials and other spectators. Police may be called if necessary.
- The stadium reserves the right to ban any individual from entering the premises depending on the severity of the incident and for repeat offenders. Any negative student behaviour reported to the school will be investigated and may result in disciplinary action.
