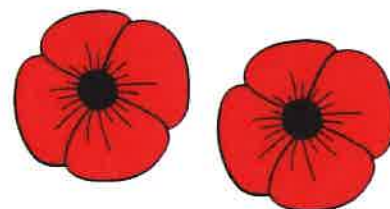

Wednesday 17 April—Old Tailem Town Excursion

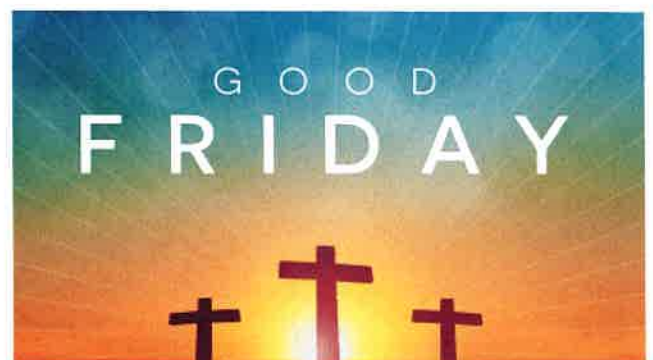

GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOKINGS

A lot of time and planning goes into our Vacation Care program. We would appreciate all users booking into the program as soon as possible. If a booking is not cancelled the night before, the child will be charged an allowable absence. If a child wakes up sick on the morning of the excursion, the place will not be charged as long as OSHC is informed before 8am that day.

BEHAVIOUR

All children are expected to respect each other, staff, visitors, parents and anyone else in attendance at the centre as well as respecting each others property. Children with unacceptable behaviour will be placed in time out, continued unacceptable behaviour will result in a parent being contacted and possible expulsion from the program.

LOST PROPERTY

The children are expected to keep their belongings in their bags. Children need to put their bag in a locker and not on the floor. Children who remove their shoes and socks must put them in their bags immediately. Whilst all care is taken to return children's belongings to them, no responsibility will be taken by OSHC for lost or damaged property. It is recommended that all property is labelled. OSHC discourages children bringing IT items to vacation care and also advises that if brought, these items are not allowed to be charged at the centre.

EXCURSION

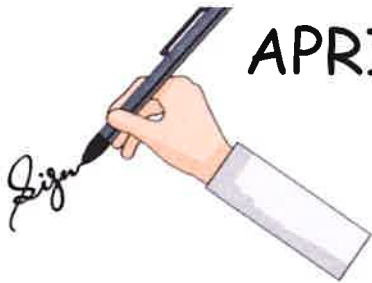
All children need to arrive at OSHC by the specified time of departure. If a child does not arrive and does not cancel, the place will be charged. If a child does not come by the scheduled departure time and we have not heard from the parent, we will go without them. Spending money is only permitted if specified in the program or arrangements are made with staff.

FOOD AND CLOTHING

All children are required to wear clothing appropriate to the weather on the day. Hats are to be brought every day and are to be worn when the UV level requires (there is a poster inside the door at OSHC which explains the levels). All children are expected to wear shoes when outside. Breakfast & afternoon tea is not provided during Vacation Care, lunch is provided on Wednesdays and the food offered will be listed in the program. Please provide your child/ren with plenty to eat and drink.

MEDICATION

All children requiring medication to be administered during their time at Vacation Care need to sign the 'Permission to administer Medication' book. All medication must be clearly labelled with the child's name, dosage and administration time. Children who require medication which assists improved behaviour MUST have their medication supplied. If medication is not supplied, the child will not be accepted into the program.
